

SUMMER VILLAGE OF POPLAR BAY

TAX INSTALLMENT PLAN

BY-LAW 218

A Bylaw in the Summer Village of Poplar Bay in the Province of Alberta, providing for a TAX INSTALLMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, R.S.A., 2000, and amendments thereto provides that a Council of a municipality may pass Bylaws to provide for the payment of property taxes by installments, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Summer Village of Poplar Bay wishes to implement a Tax Installment Plan for its ratepayers:

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Poplar Bay, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Taxpayers of the Summer Village of Poplar Bay shall, upon application to the Chief Administrative Officer, have the right to enter into a Pre-Authorized Tax Installment Payment Plan (hereinafter called "the Plan") to provide for the payment of property taxes in equal monthly installments from January to December in any year.
2. The Plan shall commence on January 1st of each year provided that all property taxes, fees, tax arrears and penalties are fully paid on or before December 31st of the preceeding year.
3. For the first six months of the current year, the taxpayer shall make a monthly payment equivalent to one twelfth of the immediate past year's tax levy. All payments are due on or before the first day of each month.

4. For the last six months of the current year, the taxpayer shall make monthly payments equivalent to one sixth of the balance of the tax levy for the current year after the deduction of payments for the first six months. All payments are due on or before the first day of each month.

5. The Summer Village of Poplar Bay Tax Penalty Bylaw does not apply to installments paid in accordance with this Plan. However, the Chief Administrative Officer shall cancel the privilege of continuing with this Plan if two consecutive payments have not been honored and the unpaid balance of taxes, if any, shall be subject to the provisions of the Tax Penalty Bylaw.


THIS BYLAW RESCINDS BYLAW #215 UPON THE DATE OF THE THIRD READING

Read a first time this 23rd day of October, 2009.



Read a second time this 23rd day of October, 2009.
