

**SUMMER VILLAGE OF POPLAR BAY**

**TAXATION RATES for 2011  
BYLAW NO. 227**

**A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE TAXATION RATES  
TO BE LEVIED AGAINST ASSESSABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE  
SUMMER VILLAGE OF POPLAR BAY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA,  
FOR THE 2011 TAXATION YEAR.**

**Whereas**, the Summer Village of Poplar Bay, in the Province of Alberta, has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of the municipal revenue and expenditures as required, at a Council Meeting held on February 25th, 2011; and

**Whereas**, the estimated municipal revenues from all sources other than taxation are estimated at \$35,854 and

**Whereas**, the estimated municipal expenditures and transfers (excluding non cash items) set out in the budget for the Summer Village of Poplar Bay, in the Province of Alberta, for 2011 total \$249,394; and the balance of \$213,540 to be raised by general municipal property taxation and;

**THEREFORE** the total amount to be raised by general municipal taxation is \$213,540 and;

**Whereas**, the requisitions are:

Alberta School Foundation Fund (ASFF)	
Residential	\$315,192
Non-Residential	\$ 1,122
Total	<u>\$316,314</u>

**Whereas**, Council of the Summer Village of Poplar Bay, in the Province of Alberta, is required each year to levy on the assessed value of all property tax rates sufficient to meet the estimated expenditures and requisitions; and

**Whereas**, Council is authorized to classify assessed property and to establish different rates of taxation in respect to each class of property, subject to the *Municipal Government Act*, Chapter M26-1, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000; and

**Whereas**, the assessed value of all property in the Summer Village of Poplar Bay, in the Province of Alberta, as shown on the assessment roll is:

**Now therefore**, under the authority of the *Municipal Government Act*, the Council of the Summer Village of Poplar Bay, in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. That the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to levy the following rates of taxation on the assessed value of all property as shown on the assessment roll of the Summer Village of Poplar Bay, in the Province of Alberta:

2. That the minimum amount payable per parcel as property tax for general municipal purposes shall be \$479.
3. That this bylaw shall take effect on the date of the third and final reading.
