1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Brousseau called the August 12, 2016 Town of Smoky Lake Public Hearing to order at 9:05 a.m. The Mayor announced that the Public Hearing for the Land Use Bylaw Amendment being Bylaw No. 007-16 was in session.

2. INTRODUCTIONS

Mayor Brousseau welcomed everyone and introductions were made.

3. PURPOSE

Chief Administrative Officer, Adam Kozakiewicz announced the purpose of the hearing being for the Council of the Town to hear testimony and take action related to the Land Use Bylaw Amendment.

Proposed Town Bylaw 007-16 – Land Use Bylaw Amendment has been advertised and notice has been provided in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000.

Section 606(2) states:

(2) Notice of the bylaw, resolution, meeting, public hearing or other thing must be:

(a) published at least once a week for 2 consecutive weeks in at least one newspaper or other publication circulating in the area to which the proposed bylaw, resolution or other thing relates,



or in which the meeting or hearing is to be held, or

(b) mailed or delivered to every residence in the area to which the proposed bylaw, resolution or other thing relates, or in which the meeting or hearing is to be held.

4. BACKGROUND

Bylaw 007-16 was presented for first reading on June 17, 2016.

The Public Hearing notices were advertised in the Smoky Lake Signal the weeks of July 27, 2016 and August 3, 2016.

This hearing has been scheduled to obtain public input on proposed Bylaw in accordance with Section 230 of the Municipal Government Act.

5. PUBLIC PRESENTATIONS

Mayor Brousseau asked if the Public had any questions or points of clarification they wished to ask of the CAO and asked upon the public to speak.

Question: Does the Bylaw have any effect on the material used?

Answer: No it does not.

6. WRITTEN SUBMISSIONS

The Mayor asked the Chief Administrative Officer if there were any written materials that have been submitted.

The Chief Administrative Officer replied that none have been submitted.

Mayor Brousseau asked if there were any other questions about the Land Use Bylaw Amendment. With no further speakers or testimony, Mayor Brousseau closed the Public Hearing.


