"Where HOPE outshines grief"

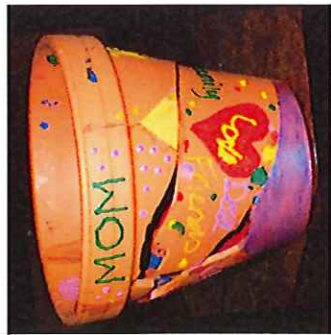
