

# 2018 Baba's Bazaar Vendor Application and Contract

Thank you for your interest in participating in Baba's Bazaar. This document includes:

### NEW in 2018

- The festival is in **LAMONT, AB**, a community of 1,800 30 minutes closer to metro Edmonton.
- Baba's Bazaar will be in the **MAIN HALL 4844-49 St, Lamont**. *This space has high visibility right off the lobby, is bright & more intimate. It will also be the location for some talks and demos as space permits.*
- With a couple tiny exceptions vendor fees have **stayed the same as 2017**. **Your fee includes:**
  - Professional tradeshow booths in 10 x 10' multiples
  - Drape, 1 table (with skirting) and 2 chairs. **Additional tables are available at \$20 each.**
  - **LIMITED power access is available for an additional cost of \$35 per outlet**
  - Cell phone reception! And free WiFi.
  - Overnight security will be provided by a professional security company
- **Outdoor spaces** are available with vendor supplying the tent
- An **Early Bird Loyalty pricing discount** for returning 2017 vendors who apply before March 31<sup>st</sup>.

### **NEW OPPORTUNITY---Outdoor Market**

As you know, regular Bazaar vendors must be Ukrainian-themed retailers or educational exhibitors (like museums).

However, there is an unmet need for farmer's market/ trade show type vendors selling garden veggies or products like jewelry, handcrafts, Epicure, Watkins, etc.

This year, we are creating a new category of vendors to supplement our primary focus that remains clearly Ukrainian. **Vendors falling into the new category will be OUTSIDE and need to provide their own tent, tables, chair.**

**Outdoor vendor spaces (10' multiples) will be clearly marked and adjacent to the outdoor attractions: Music Jam stage, outdoor beer garden, and food trucks.**

Babas & Borshch will give preference to **Ukrainian-themed** vendors and exhibitors. Decisions regarding acceptance or rejection of applications are final. Payment in full must accompany applications to be considered. Refunds will be issued to those whose applications are not accepted.

## Baba's Bazaar Rules

### Hours of Operation:

Saturday, August 25, 2018	10:00 AM to 5:00 PM
Sunday, August 26, 2018	11:00 AM to 4:00 PM

1. Displays must fit within the confines of the space rented.
2. Pets are NOT allowed in the facility with the exception of service animals.
3. Sub-letting, re-assigning or transferring rented space is NOT permitted.
4. Vendor fees are not refundable.
5. Vendors **must remain open for business during Bazaar hours and for both days of the Festival. Failure to comply will jeopardize future participation in the Bazaar.**
6. Vendors are responsible for keeping their booth space clean and free of hazards.
7. Vendors must request and pay for power at the time of application. Vendors must supply their own marked extension cords.
8. **Market garden and food vendors** must contact the Health Inspector Brian Levine (780)-895-5821 or [brian.levine2@albertahealthservices.ca](mailto:brian.levine2@albertahealthservices.ca) for applicable forms if not already in place. Permits must be displayed during the Bazaar.

### Important Deadlines:

- **Early Bird Loyalty applications/payments must be received BY March 31<sup>st</sup>**
- **Paid applications received BY April 30<sup>th</sup> will be listed in the souvenir program**
- **NO applications will be accepted AFTER August 11<sup>th</sup> because of professional show setup**
