Rules for Exhibitors

1. Entries will be accepted at the curling rink on:
 - *Thursday, June 19 , 2014 from 7:00 to 9:00 PM or
 - *Friday, June 20 , 2014 from 8:30 to 10:30 AM. Door will be locked @10:30.
 - *Quilts must arrive Thursday evening in order to be hung for judging.
 - *Judging begins Friday, June 20 at 11:00AM
2. Entries cost \$0.50 per item, up to 10 items. Over 10 items there is a flat rate of \$5.00.
YOU MAY ENTER ONLY ONE ITEM PER CLASS PER PERSON
3. Entries forms, tags, and exhibitor numbers may be obtained from Sharon Symes at the ATB beginning June 1. Please fill entry form out in NUMERICAL order. Easier if you do all this prior to coming to arena.
4. Entry forms, tags and exhibitor numbers may also be obtained at the curling rink the day of , if necessary.
5. Articles shown in the sewing and handicrafts classes need not be new, but must be cleaned and pressed.
6. One exhibit per class entry. If the article entered won a prize previously, it may not be re-entered.
7. Food items must be exhibited using a clear plastic-wrap covered plate with the tag attached to it.
8. Small articles must be attached to a card in order to avoid them getting lost.
9. Anyone wishing to display collections, hobbies for sale or exhibit, please phone 745-2283 and leave a message. These items will be displayed separately and not judged.
10. We ask that exhibits be left on display until 4:00 PM Sunday, June 22, 2014 in order to be eligible for prize money.
11. Please pick up your exhibits promptly at 4:00 PM Sunday, June 22, 2014.
