

VILLAGE OF THORSBY
BY-LAW # 2013-08

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPOSITION OF PENALTIES ON UNPAID MUNICIPAL TAXES

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Village of Thorsby in the Province of Alberta, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act Chapter M-26.1 and amendments thereto, deems it expedient to impose penalties on unpaid taxes;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Thorsby in the Province of Alberta enacts as follows:

1. Municipal taxes shall be due and payable in full on the last business day of June in each calendar year.
2. In the event of any current years taxes remaining outstanding after the due date, a penalty of 6% of the unpaid amount will be levied the first business day following the due date. A 2% penalty will be applied to outstanding current taxes at the 1st of each month from August to December.
3. A penalty of 12% shall be applied to all taxes in arrears on January 1 of each year.

By-Law #2009-07 is hereby repealed.
