

**SUMMER VILLAGE OF POPLAR BAY
BYLAW #237**

A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF POPLAR BAY TO SET SPEED LIMITS

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, and amendments thereto, provides that a Municipality may pass bylaws respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Summer Village of Poplar Bay desires to pass a bylaw to regulate speed limits within the Summer Village;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Summer Village of Poplar Bay duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

SECTION 1 – TITLE, PURPOSE AND SCOPE

- 1.1 This Bylaw shall be known as the "*Speed Limit Bylaw*".
- 1.2 The purpose of this Bylaw is to set the speed limit for roads in the Summer Village of Poplar Bay;

SECTION 2 – DEFINITIONS

In this Bylaw:

- 2.1 "*Speed Limit*" means the maximum speed legally permitted on a given stretch of road.
- 2.2 "*Roads*" means the parts of Poplar Bay Drive, Poplar Close, Poplar Cove, Poplar Crescent, Poplar Place, 1st Street and 2nd Street intended for vehicular traffic.

SECTION 3 – REQUIREMENTS

- 3.1 The speed limit on Poplar Bay Roads shall be 40 km/hour between January 1st and May 15th and between September 30th and December 31st of each year.
- 3.2 The speed limit on Poplar Bay Roads shall be 30 km/hour between May 15th and September 30th of each year.

This Bylaw repeals Poplar Bay Bylaws 40, 80 and 81 and comes into effect upon third and final reading.

Read a first time this 15th day of November, 2013.

Read a second time this 15th day of November, 2013.

Read a third time and finally passed this 15th day of November, 2013.
