

**THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF NORRIS BEACH
BYLAW No. 113**

A Bylaw of the Summer Village of Norris Beach, in the Province of Alberta (herein referred to as the Municipality) to authorize the Mayor and Chief Administrative Officer to execute an agreement with Northeast Pigeon Lake Regional Services Commission and County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 (herein collectively referred to as the Commission), for the services related to acceptance of Wastewater for residents within the municipality.

WHEREAS the Commission has requested an agreement be signed to provide the acceptance of Wastewater;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed that such an agreement would be of benefit to residents within the Municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Summer Village of Norris Beach, in the Province of Alberta, in Open Council Duly Assembled ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. Under the authority of the *Municipal Government Act*, S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26, Part 3, Division 6, Section 54, be it enacted that the Mayor and Chief Administrative Officer be authorized to sign the agreement and amendments thereto, which is attached to and forming part of this Bylaw and marked as Schedule "A".
2. Under the authority of the *Municipal Government Act*, S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26, Part 3, Division 3, Section 42(1) and Part 13, Division 4, Section 553(1)(b), be it enacted that the Chief Administrative Officer be authorized to invoice ratepayers annually, in advance, for services in accordance with the Wastewater Services Agreement. Charges that remain outstanding after December 31st shall be added to the tax roll for the parcel of land for the subsequent year and be subject to penalties as set out for outstanding taxes.
3. This Bylaw shall come into force upon being given third reading and finally passed.


