A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF MA-ME-O BEACH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING BYLAW NO. 336, BEING THE SOLID WASTE BYLAW

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to amend the Solid Waste Bylaw

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Ma-Me-O Beach, duly assembled, pursuant to the authority conferred upon it by the *Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, c.M-26* and amendments thereto, enacts as follows:

That Bylaw 336, being the Solid Waste Bylaw, be amended as follows:

Section III Regulations:

Add:

8. Yard waste shall not be collected by the waste collector; it will be the responsibility of the householder to bring this waste to the local solid waste transfer station.


This bylaw comes into effect on the date of the third reading and upon being signed.

READ a first time this 14th day of June, 2013


READ a second time this 14th day of June, 2013
