**Being a Bylaw of the Summer Village of Sundance Beach
With Respect to Smoking**

WHEREAS it has been determined that second-hand tobacco smoke (exhaled smoke and the smoke from idling cigarettes, cigars and pipes) is a health hazard or discomfort for many inhabitants of the Summer Village of Sundance Beach;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Summer Village of Sundance Beach to prohibit or regulate smoking, or both, in the Summer Village of Sundance Beach as hereafter set out;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Summer Village of Sundance Beach, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw,
 - (a) **"Village"** means the Summer Village of Sundance Beach;
 - (b) **"place of public assembly"** means a building or portion thereof used for the gathering together of persons for purposes such as deliberation, holding a workshop, entertainment, recreation, business or amusement, but does not include a place where a private social function event is being held.
 - (c) **"private social function"** means a specific social event for which an entire room or hall has been reserved, at which attendance is limited to people who have been specifically invited or designated by the sponsor, and at which the seating arrangements are under the control of the sponsor of the event and not of the proprietor of the room or hall, but does not include events which are held primarily for the purpose of business, sales or education;
 - (d) **"smoke"** or **"smoking"** includes the carrying of a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or any other lighted smoking equipment.

PLACE OF PUBLIC ASSEMBLY

No smoking.

PRIVATE SOCIAL FUNCTION

No smoking.

WASHROOMS

No person shall smoke in a washroom or toilet cubicle in any public place referred to in this Bylaw.

PENALTY

Any person who breaches any section of this bylaw listed in Schedule "A" which is attached hereto and forms part of this Bylaw, is guilty of an offence and liable to:

- (a) upon the issuance of an offence ticket, the specified fine listed in Schedule "A"; or
- (b) upon the issuance of a summons, a maximum fine of \$500.00, exclusive of costs.

ADMINISTRATION

This Bylaw shall be administered and primarily enforced by Bylaw Enforcement of the Summer Village of Sundance Beach.

This bylaw comes into force on January 1, 2003
