Please note: access will only be provided if other roadways are not an option.

- **Step one:** Provide 24 hours notice to meet a village councillor at the proposed gate to be opened. If unable to meet with a councillor, contact the Constabulary at 389-3927.
- **Step two:** Meet at the proposed time. Both the councillor and the applicant will walk the roadway and note any damages present prior to the applicant gaining access. If damages are present, these are to be noted on the bottom of this application. At that time, a meeting time will be set to inspect the fire land with the councillor and note any damages after the task is complete.
- **Step three:** the councillor will unlock the access to the fire lane (Vine Avenue) and provide access.
- **Step four:** Once the applicant has completed the task, the applicant will lock the access to the fire lane (Vine Avenue) and complete the final inspection with the councillor.

Please Note:

The fire lane (Vine Avenue) is used as a green belt by the residents of the Summer Village. The residents take pride in the lane's condition. The Summer Village residents request that all deliveries, when possible, are delivered via Lake Shore Drive.

An applicant will only be granted access if soil conditions are dry. If the fire lane is wet, access will be denied on the scheduled day.

The applicant and/or registered owner shall indemnify and save harmless the Summer Village of Sundance Beach and the councillor who provides access to Vine Avenue, from any and all losses, costs, damages, action, causes of actions, suits, claims and demands resulting from provision of access to the summer village roads
