A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF INNIFREE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADOPTING A LAND USE BYLAW FOR THE VILLAGE OF INNISFREE.


WHEREAS the *Municipal Government Act*; R.S.A. 2000, as amended, requires the Council of a municipality to enact a land use bylaw to regulate and control the use and development of land and buildings within the municipality; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Innisfree deems it desirable, expedient and in the best interest of the Village of Innisfree to adopt a new land use bylaw.


NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Innisfree enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as “The Village of Innisfree Land Use Bylaw”.
2. The Land Use Bylaw of the Village of Innisfree attached hereto as Schedule “A” to this Bylaw is hereby adopted.
3. Bylaw No. 522-98, as amended, being the previous Land Use Bylaw of the Village of Innisfree, is hereby repealed.
4. This Bylaw may be amended by Bylaw in accordance with the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A., 2000, as amended.
