

BYLAW 584/97

TOWN OF ELK POINT, ALBERTA

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ELK POINT, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AUTHORIZE THE PROVISION OF PROVINCIAL E-911 SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED TO THE TOWN OF ELK POINT.

PURSUANT TO the provisions of Sections 7 and 54 of the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, 1994, being Chapter M26.1 with amendments in force as of July 15th., 1996 and any amendments thereto.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town Of Elk Point, in the Province of Alberta, in session duly assembled, enacts as follows:

SECTION 1 - SHORT TITLE:

1.1 This bylaw shall be known as the "911 Bylaw".

SECTION 2 - PROVISION OF AGREEMENTS:

- 2.1 The Town of Elk Point will enter into an agreement with TELUS Communications Inc. to provide access to emergency services via its Provincial E-911 Service.
- 2.2 The Town Of Elk Point will enter into an agreement with Strathcona County to provide the E-911 Call Answer Service.
- 2.3 The Town Of Elk Point will enter into an agreement with TELUS Communications Inc. in order that TELUS will act as a billing and collecting agent for the Call Answer Service.
- 2.4 A customer within the Town Of Elk Point who subscribes to TELUS Exchange Service will be provided with the E-911 service and be required to pay fees for said service.

SECTION 3 - DATE OF EFFECT:


3.1 This bylaw shall take effect on the day of its final passing.
