

BYLAW 705/12
TOWN OF ELK POINT #043

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ELK POINT, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ADOPT THE TOWN OF ELK POINT AND COUNTY OF ST. PAUL NO. 19 INTER-MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS, Section 631(1) of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta, provides that two or more Councils may, by each passing a Bylaw, adopt an Inter-municipal Development Plan;

AND WHEREAS, Council deems it desirable to adopt an Inter-Municipal Development Plan with the County of St. Paul No. 19;

AND WHEREAS, Council recognizes that the lands contained within the Inter-Municipal Development Plan will remain under the jurisdiction of the County of St. Paul No. 19, and that the Inter-Municipal Development Plan provides a basis for cooperation and communication on matters of mutual interest;


AND WHEREAS, notice of the proposed Bylaw and Public Hearing was given pursuant to Section 606(2) of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta;



READ a FIRST time in Council this 13th day of February, A.D. 2012.





