A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF THE TOWN OF ELK POINT, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND THE LAND USE BYLAW, BYLAW 622/03.


WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. (the "Act") authorizes the Council to establish and amend a Land-Use Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Elk Point in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Land Use Bylaw of the Town of Elk Point, Bylaw 622/03, is hereby amended as follows:
 - a. Schedule A, the Land Use District Map, is hereby amended by changing the designation of SW ¼ - 7 - 57 - 6 w4m indicated on Schedule "A" attached hereto, from Urban Reserve (UR) to Industrial (M).
2. This bylaw here by repeals Bylaw 706/12.





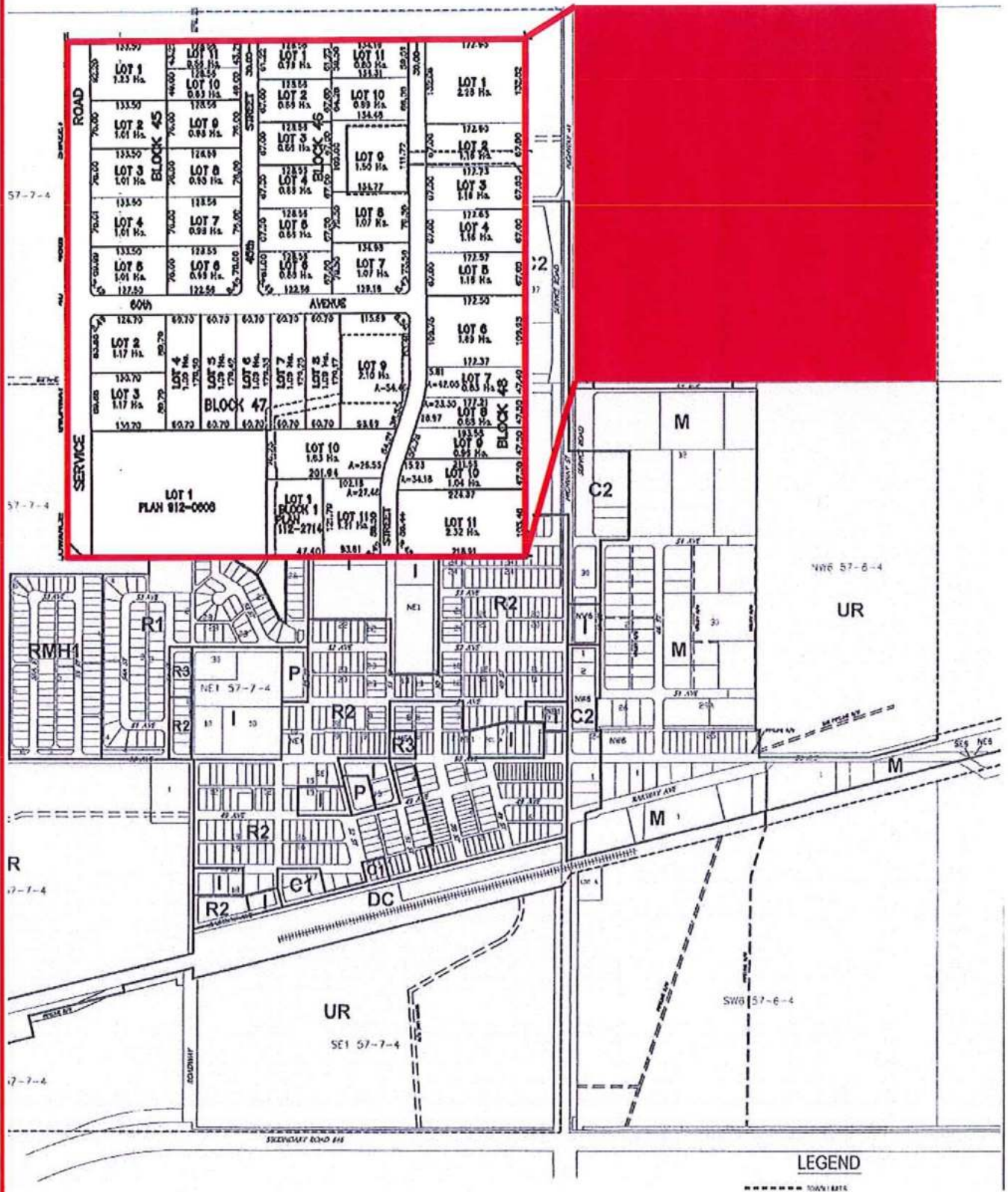
READ a SECOND time in Council this 14th day of May, A.D. 2012.
