

BYLAW 745/15
TOWN OF ELK POINT #043

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ELK POINT, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL TO AMEND A MUNICIPAL BYLAW, BYLAW 690/10, BEING THE PROCEDURAL BYLAW FOR THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ELK POINT.

PURSUANT to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter m-26 R.S.A. 2000 with amendments thereto, a Council may pass Bylaws that are considered expedient and are not contrary to this or any other Act, to establish Council and Committee procedures.

AND WHEREAS, the Municipal Council of the Town of Elk Point deems it appropriate and proper to amend the Procedural Bylaw, by adding the word twelve to replace the word nine in Clause 3.1 of the Bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ELK POINT, IN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) Section 3 – Deputy Mayor
 - 3.1 – Council shall elect one of its members as Deputy Mayor who shall hold office for a twelve (12) month term.
- 2) Bylaw 690/10 be and is hereby amended.
- 3) This Bylaw shall take effect on the date of the final passing thereof.

Read a **FIRST** time this 10 day of August, 2015.

Read a **SECOND** time this 10 day of August, 2015.

Read a **THIRD** time and **FINALLY PASSED** this 10 day of August, 2015.
