A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF THE TOWN OF ELK POINT IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO CLOSE A ROAD RIGHT OF WAY WITHIN SUBDIVISION PLAN 2130HW LOCATED WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF ELK POINT.

WHEREAS the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, as amended allows a municipality to close a road, and


WHEREAS application has been made to the Council to have the road closed, and


WHEREAS notice of the intention of the Council to pass a bylaw to close the road has been advertised in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, amended in the Elk Point Review on May 13, 2008 and on May 20, 2008, and a public hearing was held in Council offices of the Town of Elk Point on May 26, 2008, at which time no persons appeared to object to the Council passing a bylaw to close the subject lane.

1. That all that portion of Lane lying between Lot 8 and 9 in Block 21, Plan 2130HW be and is hereby closed.


