

BY-LAW NO. 145

A BY-LAW NO. 145 OF THE TOWN OF ELK POINT TO AUTHORIZE SUNDAY AFTERNOON SPORTS BETWEEN THE HOURS OF HALF PAST ONE AND SIX O'CLOCK IN THE TOWN OF ELK POINT.

WHEREAS, Some Clubs and Organizations in the Town desires to hold sports on sundays, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the fees be charged that day during such sports, and

WHEREAS, the Council have no objections, and deems it proper to hold certain sports or games on Sundays and fees charged therefor.

NOW THEREFORE, as provided under Section 5 of The Alberta Lords Day Act, 1966, the council of the Town of Elk Point enacts as follows:-


1. That Section 3 of The Alberta Lords Day Act be in force in the town of Elk Point.
2. That the following Public games, contests, and sports may be held on Sundays between the hours of half past one and six o'clock, and fees charged therefor:-

Baseball
Football
Hockey
Gymkhana
Parade
Boys & Girls Band
Tennis
Golf
Curling.


3. That the 19th day of October, A.D. 1966, between the hours of 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon and Seven o'clock in the Afternoon at the court room in the town of Elk Point, shall be the day, hour and place a poll is to be opened for taking votes of the electors on this by-law.

4. This by-law shall take effect upon having finally been passed by the council of the Town of Elk Point, after it receives majority assent of the electors of the Town.
