

BY-LAW NO. 167

A BY-LAW FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING A BUILDING FOR RECREATION PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Elk Point Curling Club was incorporated under the Societies Act, and

WHEREAS, the Club was operating as non profitable organization, and are in arrears with taxes to the sum of \$4,015.35, and

WHEREAS, the Curling Rink Building is situated on the Towns property described as Block "R" Plan 5389 C.L. and

WHEREAS, at the Curling Club's meeting held December 16th, 1968, the Elk Point Curling Club was dissolved, and the Town council were requested to take over the physical properties of the Curling Club in lieu of taxes, and

WHEREAS, the council deems it necessary and advisable to acquire the Curling Rink Building for recreation purposes for the citizens of the town.

NOW THEREFORE, as provided under Section 207 of The Municipal Government Act, the council of the Town of Elk Point enacts as follows:-

1. That the council of the Town of Elk Point be authorized to purchase from the Elk Point Curling Club the said building for the sum of \$4,015.35.
2. That the said building be used for curling purposes, and be operated by the recreation committee so appointed by the council.

READ a second time this 27th day of January, A.D. 1969.

READ a third time and passed this 10th day of march. A.D. 1969.
