

BY LAW 391/84
TOWN OF ELK POINT #043

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ELK POINT, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNCIL TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF AMUSEMENT ARCADES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF ELK POINT.

Under the authority and pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980, with amendments thereto and under Seciton 222, 238 (1), and 241 thereof, the Council of the Town of Elk Point, in Council, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

In this By-Law "Amusement Arcade" means a business whose primary purposes is the provision of games or devices for providing entertainment or amusement to the general public for a fee.

The Owner, Operator of an Amusement Arcade is required to obtain a business license of the Town of Elk Point to operate the same.

An Owner, Operator or Person in charge of an amusement arcade shall be of the full age of eighteen (18) years and shall be responsible for providing adequate, continuous and proper supervision and control of the premises, in which the business is carried on, at all time when the same is open to the general public.

An Owner, Operator or Person in charge of an amusement arcade shall not permit any person under fourteen (14) years of age, unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, to enter an amusement arcade or play therein a pinball machine or video game machine or other game or device of like nature.

An Owner, Operator, or Person in charge of an amusement arcade shall not permit any person to enter a pinball arcade or play therein a pinball machine or video game machine or other game or device of like nature;

- a) on a day other than a Sunday between the hours of 12:01 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock a.m.
- b) on a Sunday between the hours of 12:01 o'clock a.m. and 1:00 o'clock p.m.

An Owner, Operator, or Person in charge of a amusement arcade who contravenes any provision shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable upon conviction to a penalty of not less than \$100.00 or more than \$500.00 and costs.


In addition to the penalty provided above, an Owner, Operator, or Person in charge of a pinball arcade who is convicted of an offence under any section of this By-Law may have his license suspended or revoked by Town.

This By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.


