A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF ELK POINT, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROHIBITING THE DUMPING OF WASTE OIL

WHEREAS it deemed expedient and proper that the Town of Elk Point prohibit the dumping of waste oil within the Town.

THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Elk Point, duly assembled enact as follows:

- 1. No person shall dump waste oil on the roadways, alleys, and or right of ways within the Town of Elk Point,
- 2. No person shall discharge waste oil into the sanitary or storm sewers within the Town of Elk Point,
- 3. No person shall discard waste oil at any sanitary landfill,
- 4. Oil for dust control will be applied under Town supervision.
