

BYLAW 603/99

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ELK POINT, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO APPOINT THE HEAD AS IT RELATES TO THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY (FOIP) ACT.

WHEREAS, PURSUANT TO Section 89 of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act S.A. 1994 and amendments thereto, the Town of Elk Point must designate a person or group of persons as the head of the Town of Elk Point for the purposes of the Act;

THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Elk Point enacts as follows:

PURPOSE: The purpose of the Bylaw is to establish the administrative structure of the Town of Elk Point in relation to the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act.

DEFINITIONS: In this Bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires:

“Act” means the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act S.A. 1994 and amendments thereto.

“Municipality” means the Municipality of the Town of Elk Point and includes any board, committee, commission, panel, agency or corporation that is created or owned by the Town of Elk Point and all members of officers of which are appointed or chosen by the Town of Elk Point, but does not include.

Elk Point Municipal Library Board and Evergreen Waste Management Commission.

“Municipal Manager” means the person appointed as Chief Administrative Officer of the Town of Elk Point and includes any person who holds the position of Municipal Manager in an Acting Capacity.

“Province” means the Province of Alberta.

For the purposes of the act the Municipal Manager is designated as the Head of the Municipality


This Bylaw will come into effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
