TOWN OF ELK POINT

BEING A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TOWN OF ELK POINT
TO ESTABLISH AN ALLOWANCE FOR EXPENSES INCIDENTAL TO
THE DISCHARGE OF AN ELECTED OFFICER'S DUTIES

WHEREAS, the council of the Municipality of the Town of Elk Point
deems it expedient to provide an allowance to reimburse councillors for
expenses incurred during the course of their duties,

AND WHEREAS, section 275.1 (2) of the Municipal Government Act,
being Chapter M-26.1, Statutes of Alberta, 1994, and amendments thereto
provides that one third of the remuneration paid by a municipality to a
councillor is deemed to be an allowance for expenses that are incidental to
the discharge of the councillor's duties,

**NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE
MUNICIPALITY OF THE TOWN OF ELK POINT DULY
ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

That in accordance with Revenue Canada's provisions for Municipal
Officials, one-third (1/3) of the total allowance and honoraria paid to
municipal officials shall be deemed to be in lieu of expenses. The
remaining two-thirds (2/3) is income from an elected or appointed office,
and is therefore subject to income taxation and considered as earnings.
