

BYLAW 624/04

TOWN OF ELK POINT #043

A Bylaw of the Municipality of the Town of Elk Point, in the Province of Alberta, to establish the position of Designated Officer.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of section 210 of the Municipal Government Act, the Council may pass a bylaw to establish one or more positions to carry out the powers duties and function of a designated officer.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipality of the Town of Elk Point in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:


1. That the position of assessor be established to carry out the duties of an assessor as designated in the Municipal Government Act.
2. That this bylaw is effective upon the date of its third and final reading.
