

BYLAW 794/18
TOWN OF ELK POINT #043

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ELK POINT, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL TO AMEND A MUNICIPAL BYLAW, BYLAW 794/18, TO AMEND A MUNICIPAL BYLAW, BYLAW 793/18 RESPECTING THE COLLECTION, REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF ASHES, GARBAGE AND WASTE BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ELK POINT.

PURSUANT to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 R.S.A. 2000 with amendments thereto, a Council may pass Bylaws that are considered expedient and are not contrary to this or any other Act, to establish Council and Committee procedures.

AND WHEREAS, the Municipal Council of the Town of Elk Point deems it appropriate and proper to amend the Garbage Bylaw 793/18.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Elk Point, in Council assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1) Section 2.0 – Remove Subsection (k) “Enforcement Officer – means any employee so designated by the Town Manager”.
- 2) Section 2.0 (m) – Replace “means a container as approved by the collector that can be emptied by mechanical means” with “means a container as approved by the Town of Elk Point and/or collector that can be emptied by mechanical means”.
- 3) Section 2.4 – Replace “forthwith” with “without delay”
- 4) Section 2.5 – Replace “Bylaw Officer” with “Transfer Site Operator”.
- 5) Section 3.1 – Replace “Bylaw Officer” with “Landfill Certified Operator”.
- 6) Section 3.3 - Replace “Bylaw Officer” with “Superintendent of Public Works”.
- 7) Section 3.4 - Replace “Bylaw Officer” with “Superintendent of Public Works”.
- 8) Section 5.1 (b)(iv) - Replace “Bylaw Officer” with “Superintendent of Public Works”.
- 9) Section 5.1 (e) - Replace “Bylaw Officer” with “Superintendent of Public Works”.
- 10) Section 5.2 (a) - Replace “Bylaw Officer” with “Superintendent of Public Works”.
- 11) Section 6.1 (c) - Replace “Bylaw Officer” with “Superintendent of Public Works”.
- 12) Section 8.4 - Replace “Bylaw Officer” with “Transfer Site Operator”.
- 13) Section 13.0 – Replace “No person shall burn any refuse in an open or outdoor fire or use any open or outdoor fire for the burning of refuse without the express written permission of the Bylaw Officer” with “ No person shall burn any refuse at the Transfer Station without the permission of the Superintendent of Public Works.”
- 14) Add “Section 13.1 No person shall burn any refuse in an open or outdoor fire pit without the express written permission of the Bylaw Officer or Fire Chief.”
- 15) SCHEDULE “C” First Offence – Remove “or bins”

This Bylaw shall take effect on the date of the final passing thereof.

Read a **THIRD** time and **FINALLY PASSED** this 14 day of January, 2019.
