Intermunicipal Development Plan Bylaw

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF EDGERTON IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ADOPT AN INTERMUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN WITH THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF WAINWRIGHT NO. 61.

WHEREAS the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, as amended, ("the Act") requires two or more councils of municipalities that have common boundaries to adopt an intermunicipal development plan to include those areas of land lying within the boundaries of the municipalities as they consider necessary; and

WHEREAS an Intermunicipal Development Plan has been prepared for the Village of Edgerton and Municipal District of Wainwright No. 61, based on public input and studies of land use, development and other relevant data; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Edgerton has determined that it wishes to adopt an intermunicipal development plan with the Municipal District of Wainwright; and

NOW THEREFORE: the Council of the Village of Edgerton, duly assembled, and pursuant to the authority conferred upon it by the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26 as amended, enacts as follows:

1. The Village of Edgerton & MD of Wainwright Intermunicipal Development Plan is attached hereto as Schedule "A" to this Bylaw is hereby adopted.
2. This Bylaw may be cited as "Village of Edgerton & MD of Wainwright Intermunicipal Development Plan."
3. This Bylaw may be amended by Bylaw in accordance with the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, as amended.
4. Should any provision of this Bylaw be found invalid, the invalid provision shall be severed and the remaining Bylaw shall be maintained.
5. The Municipal District of Wainwright No. 61 & Village of Edgerton Intermunicipal Development Plan Bylaw #01-12 is hereby repealed.
6. This bylaw shall come into force upon receipt of its third and final reading.
