Temporary Amendment of Bylaw #12-86 Bylaw

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF EDGERTON IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO TEMPORARILY AMEND BYLAW #12-86 WHICH SETS THE TAXATION DUE DATE AND PROVIDES FOR THE IMPOSITION OF A PENALTY ON ALL CURRENTY TAXES REMAINING UNPAID ON CERTAIN SPECIFIED DATES IN THE YEAR OF THE LEVY.

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, s.7, allows Council to pass bylaws respecting property taxation;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Edgerton in the Province of Alberta duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:

That Bylaw #12-86 is amended by temporarily deleting the following wording of Section I, subsection a):

“Where any property taxes levied for the current year remain unpaid after August 31, there shall be added thereto by way of penalty, an amount of 12% (twelve per cent) of the outstanding current amount.”

And replacing with the following wording:

“Where any property taxes levied for the current year remain unpaid after September 30, there shall be added thereto by way of penalty, an amount of 8% (eight per cent) of the outstanding current amount.”

The temporary amendment shall expire on December 31st, 2020.
