

BY - LAW No 8 .

A By-Law of the Summer Village of ARGENTIA BEACH regarding discharging of firearms.

Under the authority and subject to the provisions of Section 306(e) of the Town and Village Act, 1955, being Chapter 338 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1955, and amendments thereto, the Council of the Summer Village of ARGENTIA BEACH duly assembled, enacts as follows:

That the discharging of guns or other firearms shall be prohibited at all times within the boundaries of the Summer Village of ARGENTIA BEACH, unless authorized by permit issued by the Council.

That any person who commits a breach of this By-Law shall be liable on summary conviction thereof, before a Magistrate or other Officer having jurisdiction, to a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$ 100.00) and costs, and in default thereof to imprisonment with or without hard labour in the nearest common goal for any period not exceeding sixty days (60) unless such fine and costs, including the costs of committal, are sooner paid.

This By-Law shall come into force immediately upon the passing thereof.

Read a first time this 11th day of July 1967.

Read a second time this 11th day of July 1967.

Read a third time and finally passed this 11th day of July 1967.
