THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ARGENTIA BEACH

A BY-LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ARGENTIA BEACH TO REGULATE THE USES AND TRAFFIC ON AN UNUSED ROAD ALLOWANCE ON THE BOUNDARY OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE AND THE COUNTY OF WETASKIWIN NO.10 AND JOINTLY REGULATE AND CONTROL THE USE OF CERTAIN ROAD ALLOWANCES AND PUBLIC RESERVES LOCATED IN THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ARGENTIA BEACH AND THE COUNTY OF WETASKIWIN NO.10

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26.1, R.S.A.,1994, and amendments thereto provides that a council of a municipality may pass by-laws for the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property and to regulate activities and things in, on or near a public place or place that is open to the public; and

WHEREAS the Highway Traffic Act, Chapter H-7, R.S.A.,1980 and amendments thereto allows a municipality to restrict the use of any highway with respect to any class or classes of motor vehicles; and

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act allows a municipality to agree with another municipality that a By-Law passed by one municipality has effect inside the boundaries of the other municipality if the council of each municipality passes a By-Law approving the agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Argentia Beach, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. DEFINITIONS

"bylaw enforcement officer" means a by-law enforcement officer, Peace officer, special constable or other persons employed by or under contract to the Summer Village of Argentia Beach or the County of Wetaskiwin No.10 and empowered to enforce municipal by-laws and provincial statutes.

"the Summer Village" means the Summer Village of Argentia Beach.

"the County " means the County of Wetaskiwin No.10.

"Mutual Enforcement Lands" means lands located in the Summer Village of Argentia Beach and the County of Wetaskiwin No.10.

2. LANDS AFFECTED BY THIS BY-LAW

2.1 Mutual Enforcement Lands

THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ARGENTIA BEACH

(a) The undeveloped road allowance lying to the east of Lot 1, Block 1, Plan 1945ET in the Summer Village, one half of which is located in the Summer Village and the other half in the County.

(b) The Community Reserve Parcel lying west of First Street West as shown on Plan 3680MC all of which is within the boundaries of the County.

(c) The undeveloped road allowance immediately to the east of the Community Reserve Parcel in (b) above between Lake Drive and First Avenue North, known as First Street West on Plan 3680MC all of which is within the boundaries of the County.

(d) For greater certainty, the Mutual Enforcement Lands are shaded on the map attached hereto as Schedule "A".

3. RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF LANDS

3.1 No person or persons shall, upon the Mutual Enforcement Lands:

- (a) store boats, boat hoists and other recreational equipment,
- (b) drive or operate any motor vehicle of any kind, except a snowmobile, emergency vehicle described in the Highway Traffic Act or an authorized utility or municipal maintenance vehicle,
- (c) park any motor vehicle except in the designated areas outlined in red on Schedule "A",
- (d) store any equipment or goods,
- (e) light a fire,
- (f) abandon any garbage or refuse of any kind,
- (g) cut or damage any tree or other vegetation,
- (h) interfere with the natural flow of water
- (i) interfere with wildlife,
- (j) behave in a noisy, threatening or abusive manner,
- (k) be in possession of alcohol or drugs,
- (l) be in possession of a firearm or other weapon.

3.2 Permitted Uses

- (a) Free pedestrian, bicycle and non motorized vehicle access is permitted.
- (b) Small boats may be carried in and launched by hand.
- (c) Picnicking and swimming during daylight hours only.

(d) Municipal or utility vehicles allowed access for maintenance purposes

(e) Snowmobiles are permitted.

(f) Drainage courses are to be maintained.

(g) Parking is allowed on the north 30 feet of the Community Reserve Parcel described in 2.1 (b) above and on the north 30 feet of the undeveloped road allowance described in 2.1 (c) above

4. PENALTIES

4.1 Any person who contravenes any provision of this By-Law is guilty of an offence and is liable upon conviction, to a fine not exceeding \$2,500.00

4.2 Any person may avoid prosecution for any offence under this By-Law by paying a voluntary fine of \$100.00 as shown on the violation ticket as prescribed in the Provincial Offences Procedure Act and amendments and regulations thereto. If the voluntary fine is not paid, then prosecution may be commenced.

5. ENFORCEMENT


5.1 A By-Law Enforcement Officer employed by or under contract to either the Summer Village or the County may take action to enforce this By-Law on the Mutual Enforcement Lands.

5.2 A Special Constable employed by or under contract to either the Summer Village or the County may take action to enforce this By-Law on the Mutual Enforcement Lands and any provincial statute offences authorized by Alberta Justice provided that authority is obtained from Alberta Justice


READ a first time this 12th day of November, 1996.

READ a third time and finally passed this 12th day of November, 1996.

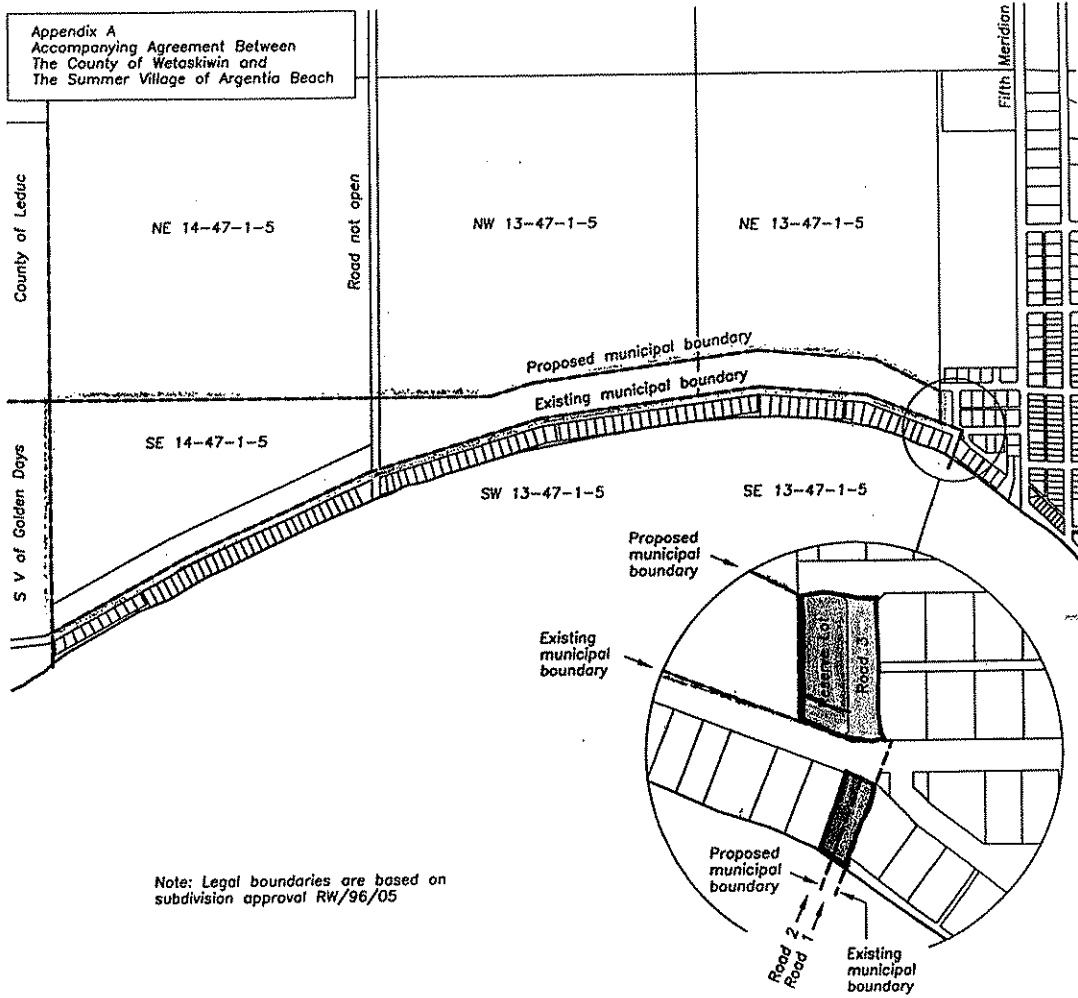
