

**A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ARGENTIA BEACH
TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 163 TO CONTROL AND REGULATE DOGS AND
ACTIVITIES IN RELATION TO DOGS**

BYLAW NO. 188

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M 26, R.S.A., 2000, Section 7(h) and amendments thereto provides that a Council of a Municipality may pass bylaws respecting wild and domestic animals and the activities in relation to them;

WHEREAS the previous definition of "Pound" refers to the "Wetaskiwin Animal Clinic" and are no longer the closest veterinary service and preference of the Council of the Summer Village of Argentia Beach deems it advisable to enact such an amendment to this Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Argentia Beach in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That Section 2(g) the definition of "pound" is deleted and the following is substituted:

2(g) "*pound*" means

2. That this bylaw shall take effect on the date of the third and final reading.
