A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ARGENTIA BEACH, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO SET FEES AND CHARGES

WHEREAS under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, and amendments thereto, the Council of the Summer Village of Argentia Beach may establish fees and charges for the provision of certain goods and services; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Summer Village of Argentia Beach deems it desirable to establish fees and charges for the provision of certain goods and services; and

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Summer Village of Argentia Beach, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be known as the Fees and Charges Bylaw
2. The Fees and Charges attached as Schedule A to this Bylaw represents the fees and charges applicable to the services provided by the Summer Village of Argentia Beach.
3. That Bylaws 166 and 171 are hereby repealed.
4. This Bylaw comes into effect upon third and final reading.

Given unanimous consent to proceed to third reading this 17th day of December, 2008.

Read a third time and finally passed this 17th day of December, 2008.

SCHEDULE A

The Summer Village of Argentia Beach shall charge the following fees:

1. \$0.25 per page of information (\$0.50 per double-sided page) to a maximum charge of \$150. Information will be double sided whenever possible.
2. \$20.00 for a tax certificate
3. \$20.00 will be applied to all returned (NSF) cheques
4. \$50.00 administrative fee will be charged for each late payment and for any payment made by the Summer Village on behalf of Summer Village residents
5. All other materials, preparation time, media and delivery costs for information disclosure not identified by policy or any other bylaw will be charged in accordance with the fees and charges as set out by Schedule 2 of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Regulations.
