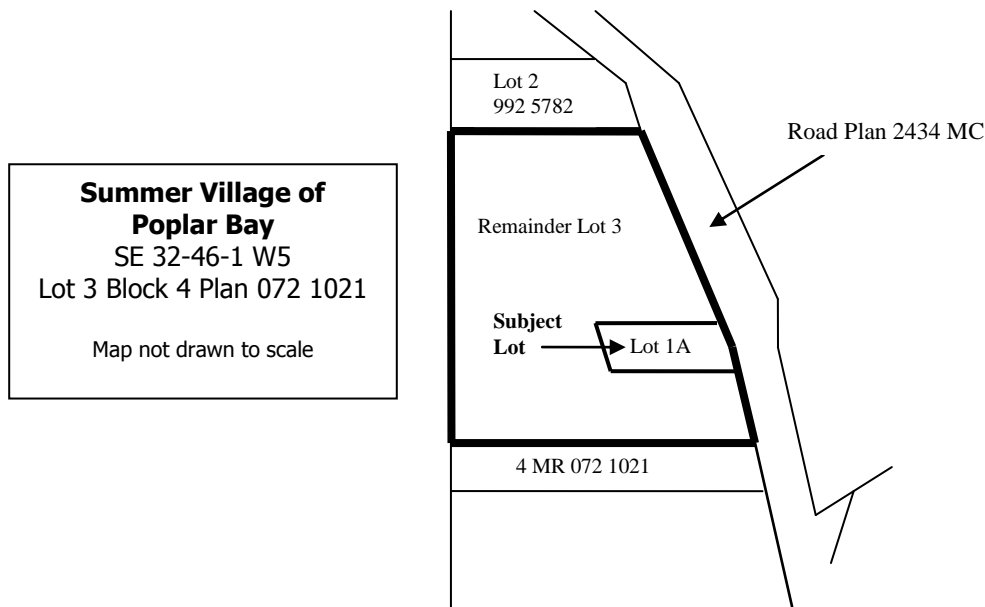
The purpose of the Bylaw is to redistrict the following lands: Part of Lot 3, Block 4, Plan 072 1021 as shown as Lot 1 A on the map below from A – Agricultural to R – Residential.

The Public Hearing for Bylaw No 228 will be held on April 26, 2011 at 10:00 AM in the Summer Villages Office at 605 – 2nd Ave., Ma Me O Beach, Alberta, at which time written and oral submissions can be presented to Council. Submissions may be made by any person(s) who claim to be affected by the proposed amendment or from any other person whom Council agrees to hear.

Written and oral submissions may also be made at the Council meeting, without prior notification to the Summer Village of Poplar Bay.
