Residential Dust Abatement – Oil Product

Policy Statement:

Lamont County will allow individuals to oil portions of gravel roadways within the municipality or, upon request, undertake the work with County forces.

Purpose:

To control dust on graveled roads in front of residences.

Application of This Policy:

1. Each year, prior to the beginning of the County's dust abatement program, Council will set the rate for the application of a standard 400' long strip of dust abatement.

The rate will be:

Dust abatement using MC 250: \$2,500.00

2. Should a ratepayer desire the County to apply dust abatement adjacent to their residence, prior to application of the dust abatement product the ratepayer will:

- (i) pay in advance for the cost of this work;
- (ii) complete a Dust Abatement Agreement.

This work will then be scheduled to be completed in conjunction with the County's annual dust abatement program.

3. Should a ratepayer desire, the County may "touch-up" an area which has received an application of dust abatement within the previous three years, upon the following conditions:

- (i) cost of this work will be 50% of the current rate, with payment to be made in advance;
- (ii) the work will be scheduled to be completed in conjunction with the County's annual dust abatement program;
- (iii) such "touch-up" work will include scarifying, oiling and re-laying of the existing dust abatement area.
- (iv) such "touch-up" work may be inspected and reviewed at the discretion of the Public Works Road Maintenance Supervisor,

4. Should a ratepayer decide to arrange for the application of their own dust abatement, they will:

- (i) ensure that the product to be applied is approved by the County and meets environmental guidelines;
- (ii) complete a Dust Abatement Agreement;
- (iii) notify the County 24 hours prior to the delivery of the product so the County can arrange to have a grader on site to work the product into the existing road gravel.

5. Notwithstanding any application of dust abatement product, the County reserves the right to maintain the road(s) at any time, as required.

6. Dust abatement materials and schedules are set during the winter/spring immediately following budget approval. In order to allow for planning and logistics of the dust abatement program, any dust abatement not **paid for by May 1st** of each year will not be guaranteed to be done. Applications for dust abatement paid for after May 1st of each year will be at the discretion of the Director of Public Works or their designate. The decision to apply a late dust abatement application will be done provided that:

- (i) There are adequate resources of oil and gravel to complete the dust abatement program as scheduled/budgeted;
- (ii) The additional dust abatement can be scheduled so as to not affect the existing dust abatement schedule as set out during the winter of each year.

Policy Statement:

Lamont County will allow individuals the ability to apply for dust abatement Calcium Product (i.e. Tiger Inhibited 35) on portions of gravel roadways within the municipality. This shall be upon request and undertaken by County forces.

Purpose:

To control dust on graveled roads in front of residences.

Application of This Policy:

1. Each year, prior to the beginning of the County’s dust abatement program, Council will set the rate for the application of a standard 400’ long strip of dust abatement.

The rate will be:

Dust abatement using Calcium Product (ie.Tiger Inhibited 35) at a rate of \$1,100.00

2. Should a ratepayer desire the County to apply dust abatement adjacent to their residence, prior to application of the dust abatement product the ratepayer will:

- (i) pay in advance for the cost of this work;
- (ii) complete a Dust Abatement Agreement

This work will then be scheduled to be completed in conjunction with the County’s annual dust abatement program.

3. Ratepayers acknowledge and agree that the application and dust abatement product is intended to last for the current calendar year.

4. Should a ratepayer decide to arrange for the application of their own dust abatement, they will:

- (i) ensure that the product to be applied is approved by the County and meets environmental guidelines;
- (ii) complete a Dust Abatement Agreement;

(iii) notify the County 24 hours prior to the delivery of the product so the County can arrange to have a grader on site to work the product into the existing road gravel.

5. Notwithstanding any application of dust abatement product, the County reserves the right to maintain the road(s) at any time, as required.

6. Dust abatement materials and schedule are set during the winter/spring immediately following budget approval. In order to allow for planning and logistics of the dust abatement program, any dust abatement **NOT PAID FOR BY MAY 31 ST** of each year will not be guaranteed to be done. Applications for dust abatement paid for after **MAY 31 ST** of each year will be at the discretion of the Director of Public Works or their designate. The decision to apply a late dust abatement application will be done provided that:

(i) There are adequate resources of oil and gravel to complete the dust abatement program as scheduled/budgeted

(ii) The additional dust abatement can be scheduled so as to not affect the existing dust abatement schedule as set out during the winter of each year.
