

**UTILITY RATE INCREASE**

Utility Rate Increase

Please be advised that as per Water and Sewer Regulations Bylaw 2015/07 Schedule "A" & Schedule "B" as well as Fee Policy #26 rates will increase effective Jan 1, 2016.

**Water Service Rates**

Residential

\$50.40 for the first 15 cubic meters and \$2.25 for each additional cubic meter of water thereafter.

Commercial

\$59.36 for the first 15 cubic meters and \$2.25 for each additional cubic meter of water thereafter.

Public & Institutional

\$63.00 for the first 15 cubic meters and \$2.25 for each additional cubic meter of water thereafter.

Churches, Clubs, Associations, Charitable

Organizations

\$30.00 for the first 15 cubic meters and \$2.25 for each additional cubic meter of water thereafter.

Additional Fees

Disconnection Fee \$25

Reconnection Fee \$25

Transfer arrears from Utility to tax roll administration fee \$25.00

Flat Rate for all mobile home units and damaged meters \$90.00/billing period

Penalties

A 3.9% penalty shall be added to the current balance if payment is not received on the date indicated on each bill.

\$20 per month

Commercial

Car Wash \$52.80 per month per stall

All other commercial businesses \$26.40 per month

Plus 50% of the amount charged over and above the flat rate for water consumption pursuant to Schedule "A" Bylaw 2015/07 for COMMERCIAL users only

\$116.40 per month

\$20.00 per month

**ATTN: RENTAL PROPERTY OWNERS**

"The Owner of a Property, and not the tenant, shall be responsible for making an Application for Utility Services with the Town. However, to allow for transition, a Tenant whose account is in good standing at the time this Bylaw comes into effect may continue to receive Utility Services until such a time as the tenant closes the account, or alternatively, the Utility Services are discontinued for any reason."

### PLEASE PUT YOUR GARBAGE CARTS BACK!!

Bylaw 2012/02, being the Waste Management Bylaw states, "Where receptacles are placed in the front or on the side of a property for collection of residential waste, they must be removed from the front or side property on the same day that the collection has been made." **PLEASE have your carts put back on your property the day of pick up to avoid a fine of \$200.**
