## **Clarification Regarding Haul Fees - Suspended**

On January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2016, the County of Wetaskiwin released a statement that provides clarity regarding User Fees that they had implemented on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016.

Effective immediately, the County of Wetaskiwin is suspending the new \$30 user fee that was implemented on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016 for Septic Haulers for each bulk load delivered to the Mulhurst Bay Lagoon.

The \$30 fee was implemented to correlate with the anticipated commencement of operations of the new Westerose Dump Station, which is part of the new South Pigeon Lake Wastewater Collection System. The temporary suspension of the \$30 fee for Mulhurst Lagoon users is due to an unexpected delay in the commencement of operations of the Westerose Station and will remain suspended until the station commences operations. Haulers that have collected fees from customers as a result of the \$30 fee are being requested to refund those fees to their customers.

We have been working collaboratively with Wetaskiwin County and the local haulers to expediently address this unfortunate user fee charge. We apologize for the confusion this may have caused.
