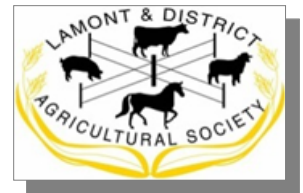

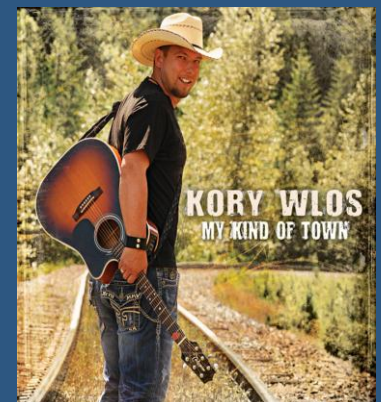

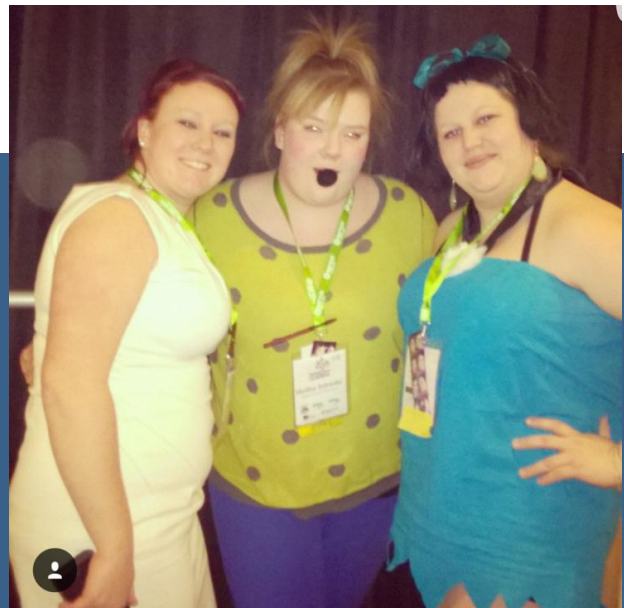


## Member Spotlight, Jesse Gruber
