## NEW BYLAWS



Sundance Beach Council has passed **three (3) important new bylaws** that will affect residents in our community in 2016.

## ANIMAL CONTROL BYLAW



- Purpose of this bylaw is to regulate and control animals.
- Dog shall be under control of owner and held on a leash when it is off the property.
- Dog cannot bark or howl in a manner that will disturb others.
- Owner must remove dog defecation left on public or private property.
- Cats may not enter onto private property other than private property of the Owner.
- A person guilty of an offence is liable to pay a fine.

## RESTRICTED USE OF FERTILIZER AND PESTICIDES BYLAW



- Purpose of this bylaw is to restrict the use of fertilizers and pesticides.
- No person is allowed to apply fertilizers or pesticides on any property in Sundance Beach.
- Some exceptions are permitted (a) for applying fertilizers that do not contain phosphorous or phosphate and (b) for pesticides used to control noxious weeds or unwanted insects/pests.
- A person guilty of an offence is liable to pay a fine.

## WASTEWATER BYLAW



- Purpose of this bylaw is to regulate, manage and maintain private wastewater disposal systems.
- All properties must contain all wastewater in a water tight holding tank.
- All wastewater pipes must be connected to a holding tank.
- All existing Private Wastewater Disposal Systems **shall be inspected by a Certified maintenance Inspector no later than September 30, 2016** and every 5 years thereafter.
