Highlights from the Library Manager's Council Meeting

- Library Managers approved the addition of the Niche Academy to the electronic resources which will provide training to staff and the general public on a variety of topics.

 - ✚ Increase in vandalism – Libraries are looking into their working alone policies and adding additional security measures whenever possible.
 - ✚ Need for NLLS advocacy at local Councils so they understand the importance of libraries and the services provided by NLLS – libraries will e-mail Julie requesting presentations before their Town and County Councils.
 - ✚ New TRAC App is very frustrating to use – Some improvements have been made.
 - ✚ Training of library staff – Ipad leap training on May 25th at the LMC Meeting.
