**Notices-** Notice is hereby given that the combined assessment/tax notices were mailed on May 27, 2016 the assessment roll is available for inspection at the Town of Mundare Administration office. The 2016 taxes are due and payable on or before July 31, 2016. Unpaid taxes are subject to a 10% penalty on August 1, 2016 and a 10% penalty on January 1, 2017.
