Subject: Closing of the Region of St. Paul Reception Center

Dear Sir/Madam,

This notice is to inform you that Effective Monday June 27, 2016 the Region of St. Paul Reception Center will be closing, and all services will no longer be available to evacuees. It has been identified that the level of service for evacuees is no longer to the level required for the evacuees residing in St. Paul.

What this means for you:

- **All accommodations will no longer be covered financially by the Region of St. Paul. If you opt to stay in your accommodations, you will be required to cover these expenses out of pocket.**

Evacuees have been provided information to get in touch with Alberta Works and Red Cross for financial support, transportation services and lodging support. It is important that evacuees get in touch with these services prior to June 27, 2016 to make long term arrangements.
