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## Minimum Qualifications For Membership

Thank you for your interest in becoming a member of the Edgerton Emergency Services Department. In order to be considered for a position with the Department, you must meet the following criteria:

1. Reside in the Village of Edgerton or within the Edgerton Fire Protection District within the MD of Wainwright, No. 61;
2. Be at least 18 years of age;
3. Hold a valid Alberta Operators License Class “5” with air brakes “Q” endorsement;
4. Provide a current drivers abstract;
5. Provide a current (within 30 days of the application) Criminal Records Check from the RCMP or any other accredited Police Agency;
6. Be physically fit to the level required to perform all functions, tasks of a Firefighter/First Responder. A medical examination may be requested; any costs involved will be expended by the candidate.
7. Hold a current Standard First Aid Certificate with Level “C” CPR, current within one year of issue.
8. Complete and submit a Department application available at the Village of Edgerton Office, 5037 – 50 Avenue, Edgerton (780-755-3933). Completed applications are to be submitted at the Village of Edgerton Office in a sealed envelope addressed to the “Emergency Services Manager.”
