Dear Friends:

Thank you for your generous contribution of hams and turkeys to our Extravaganza prize lineup.

We made the decision at our Nov. 2 meeting that we will not go with radio advertising this year, so will not need your financial help with that. If you wished to contribute toward the newspaper advertising budgeted amount of \$376 instead, we would gratefully accept that assistance.

We would request permission for the closure of one block of 50 Street, from 49 Ave. to Railway Ave. and Railway Ave. from 50 St. to 51 Street from 1 p.m. until the conclusion of the parade, approximately 6:30 p.m. on Saturday, Nov. 26 for Extravaganza activities (tractor and wagon traffic and parade lineup only), and for the use of barricades to close these areas off for that time period. We will move the barricades at 50 St. and 49 Ave. to close off the avenue during the parade and then will remove them.

We would also ask for the use of the fire pit and a supply of firewood at the west end of the EcoCentre parking lot. The fire department has assured us that they will light and take care of the bonfire, which will be lit at 2 p.m.

Events at this year's Extravaganza will include:

- Tractor-drawn wagon rides, courtesy of Prairie Tech and Truck-in 2000
- Hockey shoot-out sponsored by Servus Credit Union
- Hot chocolate and cookies served by FCSS
- Santa photos at the Co-op
- Parade (same route as Canada Day) at 6 p.m.
- Fireworks at 7 p.m.

We hope this meets with your approval. Thank you.
