



EQUIPMENT OPERATOR

Full Time – 40 hours per week

Reporting to the Public Works Foreman, the Equipment Operator shall be responsible for, but is not limited to daily equipment operations, residential waste collection, maintenance of roads, sidewalks, water & sewer infrastructure and maintenance of vehicles and equipment.

Requirements include:
