WASTEWATER SYSTEM UPDATE

Attention Norris Beach Property Owners:

As you can see in the attached Notice of Construction from Kana Oilfield Services Ltd., construction on your wastewater system is about to begin. In fact, we expect to see activity in Norris Beach starting on April 24th.

This is the first phase of the project - the installation of the main lines and related curb stop valves located on Municipal Property throughout the Summer Village. The funding for this portion of the work is in place. There will be no additional taxes or fees related to this phase of the system.

The second phase of the project will be installing lines from the curb stop valves near the main line to your holding tank. This line will be directionally drilled and will have a capped end sticking out near the tank with some extra line left available for the installation into the tank. You will be notified before any work begins on your property. We expect this work to follow closely on the heels of the main line installation.

If you are installing a new holding tank, you are probably trying to decide what type of tank to get and who to purchase it from. The engineering firm will be providing us with a short list of approved suppliers very soon and we will be posting it on the website.

Council is considering a proposal from the contractor that would see the service connection line connected into the tank at the same time as the on lot connection line is drilled. We will update you on that aspect of the service connection when we know more about the costs and any construction concerns.

The final phase will be the installation of the pumps and rails into your holding tanks. It is the responsibility of the resident to ensure that the appropriate electrical connection is provided at the tank. The engineering firm will approve several contractors who will be responsible for providing an electrical service that meets the engineering standards. As this will be tailored to the needs of the individual situation, the contractor will meet with you to arrange for the work to be done.

This is an exciting time for all of us as the wastewater system construction is now underway.
