BYLAW NO. 775.17 ROAD CLOSURE BYLAW

A BYLAW OF LAMONT COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING PUBLIC TRAVEL AND DISPOSING OF A PORTIONS OF AN UNDEVELOPED ROAD ALLOWANCE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M26.1, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have the undeveloped road allowance closed, and

WHEREAS the Council of Lamont County deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and therefore disposing of same, and

WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and

WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of Lamont County, in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel for the purpose of disposing of the undeveloped road allowance, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

Undeveloped Road Allowance between
NE 21 & SE 28-56-20-W4 and NW 21 & SW 28-56-20-W4
EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS
