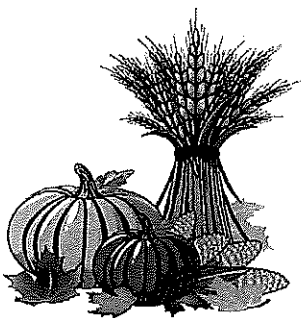

TIPP—TAX INSTALLMENT PAYMENT PLAN

The Town of Millet offers a Tax Instalment Payment Plan. TIPP is a popular program that allows you to pay your property tax on a monthly basis instead of one annual payment in June. After you enroll in this plan, your monthly payment automatically withdrawn directly from your bank account on the 1st or 16th day of every month, making budgeting easier and you can be certain your property taxes are paid in full each year, eliminating the risk of an

18% penalty.

Come down to the Town Office before December 1, 2017 to see if you are eligible for the Tax Installment Payment Plan.

The **playground zone** speed limit is 30 km/h. It is in effect every day of the year from **8:30 a.m. to one hour after sunset.**



The **school zone** speed limit is 30 km/h, and is in effect between the following times on school days: **8 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. on school days.**
