- Newspapers, flyers, inserts, junk mail
- Telephone books
- Shredded paper (please bag)
- Gift and packing paper
- Cereal Boxes
- Aluminum soft drink & beer cans
- Milk cartons
- Juice cartons and boxes
- Household tin cans
- Plastic soft drink containers

Any plastic item with the following symbol:



**NO**

- Wax or plastic coated cardboard
- Soiled tissues, napkins and paper towels
- Food waste of any kind
- Styrofoam or other foam packing
- Household garbage,
- Grass clippings, tree branches, dirt or soil, etc.
- Medical waste or diapers
- Hazardous material such as chemicals or solvents
- Paint or paint thinners
- Ashes, dirt, concrete or other heavy materials
- Shingles, plywood, or other construction materials
- Automotive parts, tires, oil filters or oil
