



Sunnybrook Solid Waste Transfer Station Access Cards

USER INFORMATION



Cards may be purchased from Leduc County by summer village/village administration only. Identification and verification of order by purchase order will be required. Public cannot purchase cards from Leduc County.

The card entitles the bearer to **ONE-TIME ACCESS** to the services offered at the Leduc County Sunnybrook Solid Waste Transfer Station only.

The card must be collected by the attendant prior to allowing access to services at the site during site operating hours: currently set as Wednesday 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Saturday 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The suitability and quantity of material shall be controlled at the discretion of the site attendant and is expected to meet with the following criteria:

- Load sizes are not to exceed a typical 8-foot (2.4 m) pickup box filled to no greater than a depth of 3 feet (0.9 m). Approximate total volume of up to 3.5 cubic yards (2.7 m³) only will be allowed per facility access.
- Vehicles exceeding three tons will not be granted access. Pickup trucks, cars, vans and utility-sized trailers will be granted access.

Materials **ACCEPTED** at the Leduc County Sunnybrook Solid Waste Transfer Station:

- household waste
- household hazardous materials - used oil and filters, antifreeze, paint and oil containers, domestic cleaners, domestic pesticides etc.
- Batteries: car, rechargeable and non-rechargeable, cell phone, etc.
- White metals: appliances, intact refrigerators, freezer and enamel-coated products, etc.
- Other metals: scrap metal, rebar, etc.
- Construction and demolition waste: drywall, painted/stained lumber, pressure-treated wood, etc.
- Tires
- Clean, non-toxic wood material
- Miscellaneous materials: furniture, bed mattress, box springs, etc.
- Recyclable materials: blue bag materials, cardboard, paper, etc.
- Electronics: televisions, computers, monitors, cell phones, etc.

Materials **NOT ACCEPTED** at the Sunnybrook Solid Waste Transfer Station:

- shingles
- dead animals

Vehicles transporting excessive volumes and excluded materials will not be granted access to the services at the Leduc County Sunnybrook Solid Waste Transfer Station and will be redirected to the Leduc and District Regional Waste Management Facility. Costs associated with disposal at the Leduc and District Regional Waste Management Facility shall be the responsibility of the resident.

All previously issued cards for summer village/village resident access are no longer valid and access will not be allowed unless a current card is presented.

THE ACCESS CARD PROVIDES ACCESS THE SUNNYBROOK SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION ONLY.
