Spray Park & Rv Park Projects to begin this Spring!

The Village of Warburg Council, in partnership with the Pioneer Agricultural Society are excited to announce the spring construction for Warburg's newest and much anticipated Spray Park attraction. In conjunction with the Spray Park, reconstruction of the existing RV Park has been approved in this year's Village budget and will begin spring construction as well.

The Spray Park will have multiple water features along with seating, and is believed to bring many village residents as well as community members to the park for enjoyment. The RV Park will see serviced (power, water & sewer) stalls, upgraded washroom facilities, permanent picnic tables, garbage & recycling cans as well as fire pits. Construction is planned to begin this spring and to be completed by the end of August of this year.

As this is a community initiative there will be many opportunities for volunteers with this project. The Pioneer Agricultural Society welcomes anyone that would like to be part of the Spray Park committee to attend our meetings held at the community hall at 7:00pm the 2nd Wednesday of each month. Removal of Ice

Please remember to keep your sidewalks snow and ice free! Ice Melt is available at the Village Office as a fundraiser for the Spray Park at \$20 a pail.

Residents are reminded that all dogs over 6 months require a license/tag and all dogs must be contained. Any dog found running at large will be picked up and a fine issued to the owner. Fines for unlicensed dogs are \$100 per dog.

Residents are reminded that anyone doing business in the Village must have a valid business license. Feel free to call the Village Office to inquire, or for a list of registered businesses.
